### RIGHTS

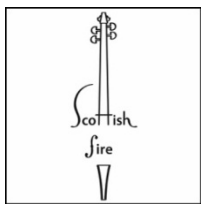

Participating composers agree that Scottish F.I.R.E. cannot be held accountable for violations of copyright that may occur.
- All reasonable efforts will be made to safeguard the entrants' personal information provided online. However, should the information be compromised, Scottish F.I.R.E. cannot be held responsible.
- By submitting a composition, entrants agree to grant performing and recording rights to Scottish F.I.R.E., whether or not that piece is selected for a prize.
- The decision on winning pieces cannot be appealed. By agreeing to take part in the contest, all competitors undertake to accept and not contest these decisions.

# Scottish F.I.R.E. Composition Competition

2017 - JIG

**JIG** (Standard, modern) – A Scottish dance tune in 6/8 that contains many eighth note patterns. This tune type is frequently, though not exclusively, a minimum of 16 measures long and generally in AB form with all parts equal in length. This tune type is not to be confused with the 9/8 jig.

## **RULES\*:**

The jig must be written for the violin.

Do not include harmonies or chords in the piece.

Do not include the composer's name or any other identifier anywhere on the music.

Application form and music must be submitted as PDFs.

Entries must be submitted by the original composer.

Scottish F.I.R.E. judges and board members are not allowed to enter.

- Failure to follow any of these rules will result in the entry being disqualified.

PDFs of the composition can be produced through any music processing program, ABC programs, or scans of handwritten notation. Handwritten notation **MUST** be completely legible.

**PRIZES\*:** **\$150** for the best composition (1<sup>st</sup> place) as determined by the judges.

**\$100** for 2<sup>nd</sup> place

**\$50** for 3<sup>rd</sup> place

\* Judges may elect not to award the prize money if there is a limited number of submissions or if the submissions do not meet the evaluation criteria sufficiently.
