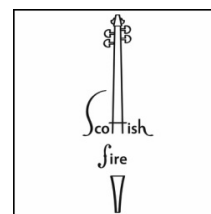


The Scottish F.I.R.E. Regional Competition Grant

The goals of Scottish F.I.R.E. are to preserve and promote Scottish fiddling through education, competition, and the support of aspiring and established Scottish fiddlers.



The SCOTTISH F.I.R.E. GRANT strives to support its regional competitions and thereby its membership through the awarding of grants. Grants may range from \$100-\$500 depending on the overall grant requests received and merit of applications.

Eligibility:

- All current F.I.R.E. Regional Competitions that are “in good standing” by being up to date with all necessary competition paperwork.
- Regional Competitions that are in the process of being established as Scottish F.I.R.E. Regional Competitions.
- **Please note:** A regional competition must become or remain a competition in “good standing” with Scottish F.I.R.E. by submitting all necessary paperwork following the competition, or any awarded grant monies will need to be repaid.

Application Process:

- In the application below, provide a detailed description of the proposed project to be undertaken with the funds provided by Scottish F.I.R.E.
 - Since the Scottish F.I.R.E. Board will base their decision on the basis of the written materials provided by applicants, the questions below need to be completed in detail.
 - Applicants are also urged to provide relevant supporting documents.
- Pay close attention to the educational aspect of the purpose of the funding, as one of the core missions of Scottish F.I.R.E. is education.
- When completing this form, please keep in mind that the requested amount may not be fully awarded, but that a partial grant may be offered based on availability of funds.
- While every effort will be made to respond to the grant request as soon as possible, please be aware that the Scottish F.I.R.E. Board meets only several times a year. Please plan your timeline accordingly as expedited applications cannot be arranged.

Instructions for Submitting a Scottish F.I.R.E. Grant Application

1. Once your application is complete, please save it in a PDF format.

3. Within 24 hours, you will receive an email confirmation from the Treasurer that your application has been received. If you do not receive a confirmation within that time, please resend your application.
